PITTSBURG FORCE MAIN IMPROVEMENTS

2.5 Miles of Sewage Pipeline Construction

March 2016 – February 2017

Delta Diablo is your wastewater resource recovery service provider. Over the next year we will begin construction in your neighborhood to install an additional force main (pressure pipeline) as part of a 2.5 mile sewer pipeline capital improvement project. This new force main is critical to help prevent overflows of other sewer lines that serve customers in Bay Point and Pittsburg. Installing this second force main will enable our agency to safely convey millions of gallons of sewage, and allow for essential rehabilitation of the existing force main which is over 35 years old. This project will also improve operational reliability and protect public health.

LOCATIONS

This notification is being mailed to businesses and residents adjacent to Project work areas. The Project will include construction in public and private right of way, including in the following streets:

- **Bainbridge Street**
- **Charleston Street**
- **E. 14th Street**
(from Solari St. to P-A Hwy)
- **Enterprise Circle** (portion)
- **Herb White Way**
(at W. 8th Street)
- **Leslie Drive**
- **Pittsburg Antioch Highway**
(from E 14th St to E. of Loveridge Rd)
- **Preservation Street**
- **Railroad Lane**
(adjacent to RR tracks)
- **Solari St**
(at Harbor St. Bridge)
- **W. 10th Street**
(at Preservation St)

COST

The total project cost, including design and construction, is \$13.6 million and is financed with a low interest loan secured from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund through an agreement with the State Water Resources Control Board. California's Clean Water State Revolving Fund is capitalized through a variety of funding sources, including grants from the United States Environmental Protection Agency and state bond proceeds.

TIMELINE

This important 2.5 mile force main improvement project will require construction in several areas of Pittsburg for a period of approximately 12 months. Construction is scheduled to begin in March 2016 and be completed by February 2017, depending upon weather. Work crews will not be in your specific neighborhood for this entire period, and we will provide updates as the project progresses.

POSSIBLE INCONVENIENCES

No full street closures will be necessary but traffic may be delayed during active work periods in the affected streets. "No Parking" signs will be posted along the street at least 3 days in advance of planned construction and parking restrictions will be enforced. Please see the posted signs for exact hours and locations as they may vary according to scheduled tasks. All other existing parking restrictions, including no parking for regular street sweeping days, will still be in effect. Access to private driveways and access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
