PITTSBURG FORCE MAIN IMPROVEMENTS

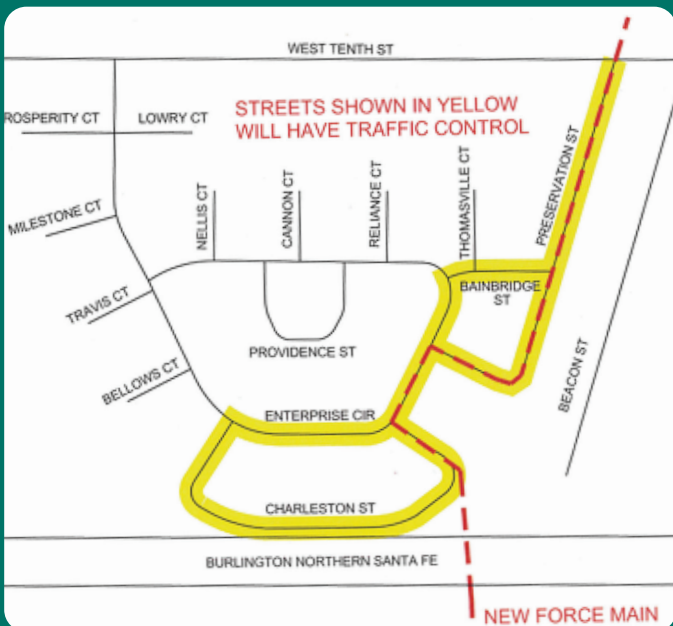
Sewage Pipeline Construction

(Heritage Pointe Subdivision: six months from summer 2016)

Delta Diablo is your wastewater resource recovery service provider. Over the next year we will begin construction in your neighborhood to install an additional force main (pressure pipeline) as part of a 2.5 mile sewer pipeline capital improvement program. This new force main is critical to help prevent overflows of other sewer lines which serve customers in Bay Point and Pittsburg. Installing this second force main will enable our agency to safely convey millions of gallons of sewage, and allow for essential rehabilitation of the existing force main which is over 35 years old. The upcoming work includes construction on some residential streets of the Heritage Pointe subdivision. A schematic of the pipeline route through Heritage Pointe is shown below.

LOCATIONS

This notification is being mailed to all residences in the Heritage Pointe Subdivision. The Project will include pipeline construction along the route shown in red, below. The contractor will also be setting up traffic control along the streets shown in yellow.



COST

The total project cost, including design and construction, is \$13.6 million and is financed with a low interest loan secured from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund through an agreement with the State Water Resources Control Board. California's Clean Water State Revolving Fund is capitalized through a variety of funding sources, including grants from the United States Environmental Protection Agency and state bond proceeds.

TIMELINE

This important 2.5 mile force main improvement project will require construction in several areas of Pittsburg for approximately 12 months. Of this timeframe, we estimate construction work within the Heritage Pointe subdivision boundaries to be for at least six months starting in the summer of 2016.

POSSIBLE INCONVENIENCES

No full street closures will be necessary but traffic may be delayed during active work periods in the affected streets. "No Parking" signs will be posted along the street at least 3 days in advance of planned construction and parking restrictions will be enforced. Please see the posted signs for exact hours and locations as they may vary according to scheduled tasks. All other parking existing restrictions, including no parking for regular street sweeping days, will still be in effect. Access to private driveways and to the mailboxes on Enterprise Circle will be maintained. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.
